



Mortgage Broker Continuing Education Information and Registration Package

We've made it easy for you to meet Continuing Education (CE) requirements in the state(s) you hold a license. CampusMBA, the educational arm of the Mortgage Bankers Association, has made the process of completing CE requirements cost effective and simple.

Most of our CE courses are available online. All of our CE courses are self-directed, meaning you can work on them anytime, anywhere.

Step 1

Review the CE State Requirements and Approved Course Listing for information in the state(s) you hold a license.

Step 2

Review the courses listed under each state. Register for the courses to meet state requirements by checking the box next to the course.

Step 3

Submit your Registration Form to the CampusMBA representative at the convention or submit your Registration Form after the convention via fax or mail. You can also register online at www.campusmba.org/courses.

How long do I have to complete each course?

You have 365 days (12 months) from the date of your course registration confirmation to complete a course. You pass the course when you have achieved an average of 75 percent or better in the quizzes and final assessment.

Please do not wait until the last minute to complete your coursework. Depending upon what is required by your state, processing of your grade, processing of additional paperwork and preparation of your certificate can take up to 10 business days.

How do I ensure I meet the CE requirement?

To ensure you have completed CE requirements to state specifications, review the State Requirements and Approved Course Listing or visit www.campusmba.org and click on *Continuing Education*. Some states require a proctor to administer the final examination, while others require the use of a time tracker.

It is your responsibility to know what is required and fulfill the requirements for your state(s).

Do I need to complete a Student Affidavit Form?

Yes. Many states require dual reporting—from the student and CampusMBA—verifying course completion. Without the form, we cannot report back to the state.

Will I receive a certificate of completion?

Upon successful completion of a course, a certificate of completion will be emailed to you.
